**TITLE:** Motion Accepting a Donation of Three Teqball Tables with an Estimated  
Value of \$7,197 from Teqball USA, LLC – **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3  
and 4)**

**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approves a motion authorizing the City Manager to accept a donation of three (3) Teqball tables from Teqball USA, LLC.

**Background**

Teqball USA, LLC, a Hungarian sport company with its principal address in California, would like to donate three (3) tables with an estimated value of \$7,197 to the City of Fort Lauderdale to assist with developing teqball as a community sport and connecting City residents through sports and games. Each table is a unique piece of equipment that can be used by adults, youth and the handicapped.

Teqball is commonly used as a game incorporating soccer and/or soccer training. The equipment looks like a ping pong table but is curved and uses a soccer ball to activate the game and/or training. These tables will be placed in an appropriate location on the beach and will be used during the City's special events that are produced throughout the year.

**Resource Impact**

This action will result in a positive impact to the city. The estimated value of the 3 donated teqball tables is \$7,197.
