Thank you for meeting with me, Steve Wofford, Church Administrator, and other members of First Presbyterian Church of Fort Lauderdale to discuss the Colee Hammock Residential Parking Permit District and the On-Street Parking Management Plan for the streets adjacent to First Presbyterian Church. We support the City's efforts to provide on-street parking and to develop a parking management plan that preserves the quality of life for the areas of Las Olas Boulevard and Colee Hammock. Although we had initial concerns about the proposed Colee Hammock Residential Parking Permit, based upon the discussions in our recent meeting and the City's decision to exempt the streets adjacent to First Presbyterian Church, we are now in support of the Residential Parking Permit plan as one element of a parking management plan for the Las Olas and Colee Hammock areas of Fort Lauderdale.
