TITLE: A resolution authorizing the execution of a deed donating portions of the

right-of-way at NE 15th Avenue and NE 17th Way along Sunrise Boulevard/State Road 838 from the City to Florida Department of

Transportation

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing execution by the proper City officials of a City deed donating to Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) portions of the right-of-way (ROW) as provided in the attachments for placement of new mast arms at NE 15th Avenue and NE 17th Way and State Road 5 (US1/Sunrise Boulevard).

Background

As part of FDOT resurfacing, restoration and rehabilitation (3-R) project, from Broward Boulevard to NE 17^{th} Way on SR -5 (US – 1/ Sunrise Boulevard), the State is requesting that the City donate these areas for the placement of new mast arms at NE 15th Avenue and NE 17th Way. These improvements are the result of a structural evaluation of the current signalization. The request provides the same right-of- way width from the baseline along both the north and south sides of the road within the project. City staff is in agreement with these improvements.
