**TITLE**: Motion to approve Third Addendum to Revocable License with B-cycle, LLC

#### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a third Addendum to the B-cycle Revocable License Agreement granted to B-cycle, LLC to expand the existing D.C. Alexander bike-share station, and authorize the City Manager to execute the Addendum on behalf of the City.

# **Background**

On July 6, 2011, the City Commission approved a Revocable License with B-Cycle, LLC, subject to Chapter 27, Article IV, of the Code of Ordinances, to allow bike-sharing stations on city-owned property.

On February 11, 2014, the Development Review Committee reviewed B-cycle LLC's application for the expansion of the D.C. Alexander Park bike-sharing station and found it in compliance with the criteria regarding location of bicycle sharing stations as provided in Chapter 27, Article IV of the Code of Ordinances.

At its Conference Meeting of March 4, 2014, the City Commission reviewed proposed plans for the renovation of D.C. Alexander Park. The applicant has been made aware that any relocation of the D.C. Alexander Park station necessitated by the renovation of the park shall be at the applicant's expense.

In accordance with the proposed Third Amendment to Permit and License Agreement (**Exhibit 1**), B-Cycle LLC is requesting to expand the D.C. Alexander Park station. Site plan and location map for the station expansion are attached as part of Exhibit 1.

### Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

## **Strategic Connections**

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:
