Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a Construction Agreement, in substantially the form attached, for Commercial Boulevard Parking Improvements with Sagaris Corp., in the amount of \$2,936,160.

Background

The Commercial Parking Lot Improvements includes, but not limited to, pavement resurfacing, adding landscaping islands, ADA crosswalks, and signage installation within the parking lots along the south and north sides of East Commercial Boulevard between NE 24th Terrace and NE 51st Street.

On January 5, 2024, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 242. The City received the following three (3) bids in response to the solicitation, which was opened on February 8, 2024:

- Emerald Construction Corp. dba Neucor Construction \$3,031,808.02
- Sagaris Corp. \$2,936,160
- Home Express Corp. dba HE-Builders \$3,944,633.30

Sagaris Corp. met all the solicitation requirements of the ITB an deemed the low, responsive, and responsible bidder. Local Preference and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Preference is not applicable to this solicitation.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$2,936,160. Funds for this agreement are available in the FY 2024 Parking Fund in the account listed below.
