Mitigation Bank for the Riverwalk Extension Project

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission authorize execution of an agreement with FPL for purchase of mitigation credits from the Everglades Mitigation Bank for the Riverwalk Extension Project.

Background

The City Commission has previously approved the Riverwalk Extension Project on the north side of the New River. As the project proceeds through the permitting stage, it is necessary to purchase mitigation credits in order to compensate for the loss on on-site mangroves.

Florida Power and Light (FPL) operates the Everglades Mitigation Bank and has agreed to sell 0.01 Saltwater Mitigation Credits in order to fulfill the City's permit obligations for a fee of \$2,000.

Resource Impact:

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$2,000 for the City's permit.
