PROJECT INFORMATION

Project Title:	Riverwalk North Seawall Replacement from Andrews Ave to FEC Train Track
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Brief Project Summary:

The existing seawall located between Andrews Avenue and FEC train track is made of concrete panels with a concrete cap and T piles. Deadmans on landside assured the lateral stability of this old stretch of seawall. The seawall also serves as a line of support for a concrete catwalk (ribbed-slab) that is also supported by spandrel beams and concrete piles. This seawall system retains the subbase for the whole Riverwalk north business area. In the event of a failure, a lot of business would be affected.

The seawall itself is plagued with concrete cracks. the afore-mentioned concrete catwalk ribbed-slab has lost all its reinforcement due to corrosion and can no longer sustain the original design load it was intended to support and may be on the verge of collapse. most of the concrete piles supporting the concrete catwalk are cracked and in some instance missing good chunks of concrete. The seawall as a whole has become a public hazard.
