TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement for the Purchase and Installation of Boat

Motors - Trustworthy Marine Services, LLC - \$133,352.62 - (Commission

Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase and installation of four (4) boat motors with Trustworthy Marine Services, LLC, in the amount of \$133,352.62.

Background

The Police Department owns two (2) boats containing two (2) Mercury Verado 300HP I6 STS Outboard Engine motors that have reached their lifetime expectancy. To maintain a safe and reliable operation of the boats the two vessels require replacement of their two current engines with new Mercury 300 V8 Verado engines. The Department request that the City Commission approves the purchase, removal, and installation of four (4) boat motors to meet its marine operation needs.

On August 14, 2024, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 356 – Purchase and Installation of Boat Motors. When the bid closed on August 27, 2024, three (3) responses were received.

Canamer submitted a "no bid" response. Man O' War Marine's bid was deemed non-responsive because it failed to adhere to the bid instructions of the ITB causing a discrepancy between the electronic bid submitted and its supporting documentation attached to its bid. Since the electronic bid prevails, Man O' War is unable to honor its bid prices. The remaining bidder, Trustworthy Marine Services, LLC has met all of the solicitation requirements and is the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$133,352.62. Funds are available in the FY 2025 Budget in the accounts listed below.
