TITLE: Motion to Approve Assignment of Contract for Administration of
Real Property in Foreclosure Services

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an assignment of contract for administration of real property in foreclosure services from Community Champions Corporation (Assignor) to Property Registration Champions, LLC (Assignee).

Background

On October 6, 2015, the City Commission approved a piggyback contract based on Manatee Agreement #13-2753DC with Assignor for administration of real property in foreclosure (CAM 15-1098).

The contract term is for one year beginning August 29, 2014 with four one-year renewal options; it is currently on the third renewal which expires August 28, 2018.

Assignor has assigned the contract, in its entirety, to Assignee, which shall perform Assignor's duties, obligations, and responsibilities under the Agreement #13-2753DC.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action.
