**TITLE:** Motion to approve the purchase of model year 2013 police vehicles,  
Invitation to Bid (ITB) 432-11114 - \$2,493,456

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission award the purchase of model year 2013 police vehicles to the single bidder, Maroone Chevrolet, LLC, a local vendor, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$2,493,456. This bid will end when the new/unused 2013 model year vehicles are no longer available.

**Background**

On September 18, 2012 (12-2162), the Commission approved the fiscal year (FY) 2013 Fleet Plan. The FY 2013 Fleet Plan includes the replacement of seventy one class 02 police pursuit vehicles. A copy of the vehicle replacement analysis for each vehicle is attached as (Exhibit 3). Furthermore the City has experienced the constructive total loss of three class 02 police pursuit vehicles due to accident damage. A copy of the declaration of total loss from Risk Management for each vehicle is attached as (Exhibit 4).

The remaining eight vehicles on the bid will be purchased only if we experience catastrophic mechanical failure or if a vehicle is declared a total loss by Risk Management during the FY 2013.

The Procurement Services Division requested bids from 363 vendors and received one response from Maroone Chevrolet, LLC, a local vendor, in the amount of \$2,493,456. The pricing offered by Maroone was compared with the pricing offered on the Florida Sheriff's contract and it was determined that the City will save \$89 for each vehicle purchased using the ITB (see Exhibit 2).

**Resource Impact**

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$2,493,456.
