

RESOLUTION NO. 14-101

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, NAMING THE AREA LOCATED AT 3850 FEDERAL HIGHWAY "MANGURIAN PARK," CONTINGENT UPON THE CITY ACQUIRING THE PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of negotiating acquisition of the property located at 3850 Federal Highway to be used as a park; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department was contacted with a proposal from Coral Ridge Golf Course, Inc. to name the park "Mangurian Park" if the City acquires the property, in honor of Harry T. Mangurian, a longtime resident of the Coral Ridge neighborhood and owner of Mangurian Furniture retail stores; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Guidelines for Naming Parks, Recreation Areas and Facilities, Parks and Recreation, staff recommends naming the property at 3850 Federal Highway as "Mangurian Park" in honor of Harry T. Mangurian; and


WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Beaches Advisory Board, at its May, 28, 2014 meeting recommended approval of the naming the property at 3850 Federal Highway as "Mangurian Park" in honor of Harry T. Mangurian; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the property located at 3850 Federal Highway shall be named as "Mangurian Park" in honor of Harry T. Mangurian, contingent upon the City acquiring the property.

SECTION 2. If the City acquires the property, the City Clerk is directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the City Engineer for future inclusion in the "Official Map of the City of Fort Lauderdale."
