## Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to F.S. Section 163.346, notice of intent is being provided by the City of Fort Lauderdale, under its delegated powers under Broward County Resolution No 89-1132, to amend Ordinance C-95-67. In accordance with the Interlocal Agreement by and between the City of Fort Lauderdale, Fort Lauderdale Community Redevelopment Agency and Broward County, Florida, the Northwest-Progresso-Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Agency has been extended for an additional ten (10) years starting from November 8, 2025. No taxing authority is required to remit tax increment revenue during this extended period except that the City of Fort Lauderdale, at its election, may decide to contribute tax increment revenue pursuant to F.S. Section 163. 387 and City of Fort Lauderdale Ordinance C-95-67, as amended, subject to certain conditions.
