TITLE: Resolution Approving City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2022 Not for Profit Grant
Participation Agreement with Gilda's Club of South Florida, Inc., - \$50,000 -
(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2022 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with Gilda's Club of South Florida, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, ("Grant Participation Agreement"), in the amount of \$50,000, and authorizing execution of the Grant Participation Agreement.

Background

With the adoption of the FY 2022 Budget, the City Commission approved contributions to not-for-profit organizations that support the needs of the community while making a positive impact. The benefiting not-for-profit organization is required to execute a participation agreement that provides for amount, terms of contribution, scope of services, and standards of performance.

The mission of Gilda's Club of South Florida, Inc., is to ensure all people impacted by cancer are empowered by knowledge, strengthened by action and sustained by community. The funding will be used to provide free-of-charge cancer support services to residents of the City of Fort Lauderdale, including seniors and families with children, to address social determinants of health, social isolation, and stress reduction.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$50,000 in FY 2022. Funding is budgeted and available in the account on the following page.
