Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission hold a public hearing and approve a resolution adopting the final budget and personnel complement for the City of Fort Lauderdale for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024, beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024.

Background

In accordance with the City Charter, Code of Ordinances and the laws of the State of Florida, the City Manager presented to the City Commission the FY 2024 Proposed Budget on July 5, 2023 (CAM #23-0354). Since the proposed budget submission, modifications have been made to the various budgets which are now reflected as the FY 2024 Final Budget.

The Final Budget of \$1,071,928,055 includes a millage rate of \$4.1193 per \$1,000 of taxable value and Fire Assessment Fee of \$338 per residential dwelling.

Exhibit 2 provides a listing of the changes that have been made since the submission of the FY 2024 Tentative Budget. Exhibit 4 includes a listing of the special event and public space activation expenses incorporated within the FY 2024 Budget. Exhibit 5 outlines the funding to support external organizations.
