**TITLE:** Motion to Approve Contract for the SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue On-Street Parking Improvements Project – Sagaris Corp - \$324,270

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue On-Street Parking Improvements Project with Sagaris Corp. (“Sagaris”), in the amount of \$324,270.

**Background**

This project is located at SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue between Broward Boulevard and SW 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The work includes repaving and restriping portion of the existing road on SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue between Broward Boulevard and SW 2<sup>nd</sup> Street that includes 18 standard parking spaces, 1 accessible parking space and 9 motorcycle parking spaces with solar panel pedestrian lights on both sides of the street.

On November 19th, 2018, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Number 12222-993. Two bids were received on January 3, 2019, and both bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. The bid submitted by Sagaris has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

**Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the Parking Fund in the amount of \$324,270.
