## **RESOLUTION NO. 13-13**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 08-63 TO CORRECT A SCRIVENER'S ERROR.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 08-63, adopted on April 1, 2008, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale vacated a 15 foot utility easement retained over the vacated alley in Block 1, "Amended Plat of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33 of North Lauderdale", according to the Plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 182 of the public records of Miami-Dade County, Florida located between Northeast 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Northeast 5<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Northeast 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

WHEREAS, due to a scrivener's error "Block 1, 'Amended Plat of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33 of North Lauderdale", was incorrectly identified as "Block 182, 'North Lauderdale" in the resolution's title;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the title of Resolution No. 08-63 is hereby amended by replacing "Block 182, 'North Lauderdale' with "Block 1, 'Amended Plat of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33 of North Lauderdale'" to read as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, VACATING THE 15-FOOT UTILITY EASEMENT RETAINED OVER THE VACATED ALLEY IN BLOCK 1, "AMENDED PLAT OF BLOCKS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 AND 33 OF NORTH LAUDERDALE", ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 1, PAGE 182, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, LOCATED BETWEEN NORTHEAST 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND NORTHEAST 5<sup>TH</sup> STREET, EAST OF NORTHEAST 5<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE, LYING AND BEING IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That except as amended, Resolution No. 08-63, adopted on April 1, 2008 is hereby ratified and reaffirmed.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That a copy of this Resolution shall be recorded in the Public Records of Broward County, within 30 days from the date of final passage.

SECTION 4. That a certified copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the applicant.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
