ORDINANCE NO. C-23-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION TABLE OF THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AS AMENDED, BY CREATING AND ADDING ONE CLASSIFICATION, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Interim City Attorney and the Acting Director - Human Resources recommend amending the Classification Table of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, by creating and adding one classification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That Exhibit 4, Classification Table, Non-Bargaining Unit, of Ordinance C-18-37, the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, as amended, is hereby amended by creating and adding in alphabetical order by title, one classification, to wit:

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That if any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the first full pay period following its final passage.
