TITLE: Motion to approve one year contract for the purchase of gate valves – Invitation to Bid (ITB) 432-11111 - \$222,586.25

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one year contract for the purchase of gate valves from the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder, Shuler Supplier Co., in the estimated amount of \$222,586.25 and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one year renewal options upon approval and appropriation of funds.

Background

Gate valves are used extensively in the maintenance, repair and improvement of the City’s water distribution system.

The Procurement Services Division sent an ITB to 612 vendors and received five responses. Shuler Supplier Co. was the low bidder for the purchase of gate valves in the estimated annual amount of \$222,586.25. Warehouse bids are created as a group. Bidders must bid on all items to be considered for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$222,586.25.
