FIRST EXTENSION TO HOME PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND HOPE SOUTH FLORIDA, INC. FOR TENANT BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE

This FIRST EXTENSION to CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE HOME PROGRAMAGREEMENT, with an effective date of August 1, 2022, is entered into on this 2/4 day of October 2022, between:

CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, with its principal address at 100 N. Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301 (hereinafter referred to as "CITY"),

and

HOPE SOUTH FLORIDA, INC., a Florida non-profit corporation, with its principal address at 1100 North Andrews, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33311 (hereinafter referred to as "Subrecipient"),

(hereinafter referred to individually as "Party" and collectively as "Parties").

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2020, CITY engaged the services of Subrecipient to administer the Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) program pursuant to an executed HOME PROGRAM AGREEMENT, with a two (2) year term ending July 30, 2022 ("Subrecipient Agreement").

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article III of the Subrecipent Agreement, titled "Term," the contract period of the Subrecipient Agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the City and Subrecipient.

WHEREAS the parties desire to extend the Subrecipient Agreement for an additional 2-year term, beginning August 1, 2022 and ending July 30, 2024; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter contained and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the CITY and Subrecipient agree as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Article III of the Subrecipient Agreement is hereby amended to extend the contract term to a period beginning August 1, 2022, and ending on July 30, 2024.
- 3. In the event of any conflict or ambiguity by and between the terms and provisions of the Subrecipient Agreement and the terms and provisions of this First Extension to the Subrecipient Agreement, this First Extension to the Subrecipient Agreement shall control.
- 4. This First Extension to the Subrecipient Agreement shall take effect upon execution

by both parties.

5. There are no other changes or amendments. The remaining terms and conditions of the Subrecipient Agreement shall remain in full force and effect, except as specifically amended by this First Extension to Subrecipient Agreement.
