

RESOLUTION NO. 15-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE 2015 WALK OF FAME INDUCTION COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, in order to foster civic pride and responsibility, encourage public service and develop appreciation of the City's heritage, it is fitting and proper that we recognize those who distinguished themselves in their respective fields while making lifelong, positive contributions to the City of Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to create a Committee whose duty will be to select those who deserve to be recognized for their life-long accomplishments by induction into the City of Fort Lauderdale's Walk of Fame;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the 2015 Walk of Fame Induction Committee is hereby created and established.

SECTION 2. That the purpose of this Committee shall be to select individuals for recognition on the City of Fort Lauderdale Walk of Fame.

SECTION 3. Membership.

The Committee shall consist of all prior inductees to the City of Fort Lauderdale Walk of Fame or their respective designees, who shall serve, without compensation, at the pleasure of the City Commission.


SECTION 4. Meetings and Procedures.

- A. The Committee shall select its own chair from its members.
- B. A majority of the members appointed to the Committee shall constitute a quorum.
- C. The Committee shall meet no more frequently than three times during the calendar year.


SECTION 5. That the Committee shall exist for a period of time commencing on April 7, 2015 and terminating on December 31, 2015.
