TITLE: Resolution Amending Agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale related to Annexation of Twin Lakes North

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution amending an agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale related to Annexation of Twin Lakes North. The amendment to the agreement would allow the City until September 20, 2019, to complete the construction of roadway improvements.

Background

On November 18, 2005, the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County entered into an interlocal agreement, effective September 14, 2005, concerning the annexation of a portion on unincorporated Broward County, known as Twin Lakes North, into the City of Fort Lauderdale. As part of the agreement, the City was obligated to install sewer improvements within the neighborhood along with certain roadway improvements. To-date, the sewer improvements have been completed.

In order to best identify the roadway and transportation needs of the Twin Lakes North Neighborhood, the City worked with the neighbors to complete a Neighborhood Mobility Master Plan which identified solutions to key transportation challenges. The Plan has been adopted by the Association and they have identified their prioritized preliminary strategies. The \$310,560 in capital funds from the Agreement will be used to design and construct those priorities over the next 12 months which includes West 10th Avenue and NW 15th Avenue to address traffic calming. The elements will include four (4) entryway monuments, a total of seven pinch points between both streets, and a roundabout at NW 10th Avenue and NW 47th Street.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal year impact associated with this item at this time.

Strategic Connections:

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Public Places Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 3: Be a community that finds opportunities and leverages partnerships to create unique, inviting, and connected gathering places that highlight our beaches, waterways, urban areas, and parks.

This item advances the *Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale 2035 Vision Plan: We are Community*.
