A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DENYING THE APPLICATION BY 909 BEVERLY, LLC, A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY FOR A DOCK PERMIT FOR THE INSTALLATION, USE, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF A TWO (2) PROPOSED 15' +/- LONG X 8.3'+/- WIDE MARGINAL WOODEN DOCKS WITH STEPS EXTENDING A MAXIMUM DISTANCE OF 5'+/- FROM THE SEAWALL CAP ON PUBLIC PROPERTY ABUTTING THE WATERWAY ADJACENT TO 909 SE 2ND STREET, PURSUANT TO SECTION 8-144 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE.

WHEREAS, Applicant applied for a permit to install, use, maintain and repair a two (2) proposed 15' +/- long x 8.3' +/- wide marginal wooden docks with steps extending a maximum distance of 5'+/- from the seawall cap on public property abutting the waterway adjacent to 909 SE 2^{nd} Street, (hereinafter "Application"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:
