TITLE: Resolution approving the submittal of a grant application to the Florida
Inland Navigation District 2014 Waterways Assistance Program, \$30,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) for the 2014 Waterways Assistance Program and authorize the City Manager to execute to necessary documents.

Background

This grant program provides funding assistance to local governments to perform waterway improvement projects. The program also funds up to \$30,000 for the initial purchase of marine law enforcement vessels and related equipment. The grant period is October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2016.

The Department will request one set of outboard motors through the grant and will meet the grant's required 50% cash match through the purchase of a second set of outboard motors. The grant will fund \$30,000 of the total \$89,800 project cost. The Department is requesting that the \$59,800 for the required match be budgeted in the General Fund in FY 2015 (FD001-9129).

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact during FY 2014. In FY 2015 there is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$30,000. Full implementation of the grant will also require \$59,800 to be budgeted in the General Fund in FY 2015 (FD001-9129).

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Commission Annual Action Plan* priority, included within the Policy Agenda, advancing the Crime Reduction Strategy and Action Plan.

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Public Safety Cylinders of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 9: Be the safest urban coastal City in South Florida through preventative and responsive police and fire protection.
- Objective 1: Prevent and solve crime in all neighborhoods.

This item advances the *Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale 2035 Vision Plan: We Are Community*.
