TITLE: Motion to approve purchase agreement for nine outdoor exercise
equipment stations, shade structure and surfacing – Clay County Contract
13/14-8 - \$72,998.86

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase and installation of nine outdoor exercise equipment stations along with associated shade structure and surfacing for Hortt Park from Rep Services, Inc. in the amount of \$72,998.86 in accordance with Clay County Contract 13/14-8.

Background

At its June 4, 2013 Regular Meeting (CAM-13-0756, M-10) the Commission approved a grant agreement with Broward County, Land Stewardship Program, Parks for People Grant, Hortt Park.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(7) of the Code of Ordinances, this purchase will be made in accordance with Clay County Contract 13/14-8 from Rep Services, Inc. in the amount of \$72,998.86, whereby such contract or formal bid followed formal bid procedures of sealed written bids, public opening and legal advertising.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$72,998.86
