TITLE: Public Hearing – Quasi-Judicial Resolution Approving a Waiver of

Limitations at Hemingway Landings Condominium located at 1414, 1424, &

1500 SE 12th Street for Existing Pilings - (Commission District 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution approving a Waiver of Limitations for multiple existing pilings located at Heminway Landings Condominium located at 1414, 1424 & 1500 SE 12th Street.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow a mooring structure to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 D of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for multiple existing piles extending a maximum distance of +/-27.7' into the adjacent Cerro Gordo River.

The applicant's Summary Description specifies that the proposed structures are necessary to safely moor the resident's vessel, especially during high winds and severe weather.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$1,500 is required.

The Marine Advisory Board (MAB) recommended approval of the application 10:0 at the September 5th, 2024, MAB meeting.
