

RESOLUTION NO. 16-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO SETTLE UNPAID ALARM FEES.

WHEREAS, from time to time, a property owner or his/her successor-in-interest desires to settle an unpaid alarm fee at less than the face value and wants to provide evidence of extenuating or special circumstances in support of a payment of a lesser fee amount than the ordinance provides; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2006 by adopting Resolution 06-122, the City Commission delegated to the City Manager the authority to settle and execute a release of any lien or debt arising from unpaid alarm response fees with certain provisions and restrictions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the authority to settle any debt arising from unpaid alarm response fees is delegated to the City Manager.

SECTION 2. That any and all Resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith, be are hereby rescinded.

SECTION 3. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage.
