TITLE: Resolution Approving the Not for Profit Service Agreement with Experience

Aviation, Inc., to Launch a Pre-Apprenticeship and Workforce Development STEM Program within the City of Fort Lauderdale – \$216,000 -

(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute the Not for Profit Service Agreement with Experience Aviation, Inc., for a total of \$216,000, to provide the City-sponsored Barrington Irving Technical Training School (BITTS), at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport for students and adults in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Background

The Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport is one of the top five largest executive airports in the country and supports over 23,000 jobs. As the aviation industry faces shortages, there are underutilized talent pools within local communities, especially in Fort Lauderdale. This program will provide a workforce education program that provides jobs for city residents in the aviation, automotive, and marine industries. The City's Education Advisory Board (EAB) has researched and communicated to the Commission its support for this program.
