TITLE: Motion to award purchase of ford interceptor police utility vehicles – Florida Sheriff’s Association Contract 13-21-0904 - \$418,350

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award the purchase of fifteen Ford Interceptor police utility vehicles utilizing Florida Sheriff’s Association Contract 13-21-0904 from Don Reid Ford, Inc. in the amount of \$418,350.

Background

The Ford Interceptors will be utilized by Police Patrol Sergeants. These vehicles will be used to transport necessary equipment during critical incidents. The Interceptors will also be instrumental during high water or storm response as the increased height of these vehicles will allow patrol to respond to scenes not currently accessible to standard patrol vehicles.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(8) of the Code of Ordinances, this purchase will be made in accordance with Florida Sheriff’s Association Contract 13-21-0904 from Don Reid Ford, Inc. in the amount of \$418,350, whereby such contract was entered into following a fair and competitive process that included public notice; sealed, written or secure electronic bids; and public bid opening.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$418,350.
