

ORDINANCE NO. C-22-58

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE NON-BARGAINING-UNIT CLASSIFICATION TABLE OF THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AS AMENDED, BY CREATING AND ADDING TWO CLASSIFICATIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Acting Director - Human Resources recommend amending the Non-Bargaining-Unit Classification Table of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, by creating and adding a Stormwater Operations Supervisor classification; and

WHEREAS, the City Auditor and the Acting Director - Human Resources recommend amending the Non-Bargaining-Unit Classification Table of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, by creating and adding a Senior Assistant City Auditor classification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Exhibit 4, Classification Table, Non-Bargaining Unit, of Ordinance C-18-37, of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, as amended, is hereby amended by creating and adding in alphabetical order by title, two classifications, to wit:


SECTION 2. That if any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.
