Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute, on behalf of the City, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Broward College to increase access to post-secondary learning.

Background

The MOU outlines areas of cooperation related to workforce training and career preparation for Fort Lauderdale residents. The intent of the partnership is to bring college programs and support services to underrepresented communities as a means of increasing awareness, exposure, and access to post-secondary learning opportunities.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item. In executing the MOU, the City agrees to make municipal facilities available for Broward College to deliver training opportunities to residents and employees. If selected training courses are subject to a fee, parties will enter a separate agreement setting forth the terms and conditions for any such training activities.
