TITLE: Resolution Approving City of Fort Lauderdale Fiscal Year 2026 Not for Profit

Grant Participation Agreement with Museum of Discovery and Science, Inc. -

\$214,800 - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a City of Fort Lauderdale Fiscal Year 2026 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement with Museum of Discovery and Science, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation, ("MODS"), in the amount of \$214,800, and authorizing execution of the agreement.

Background

With the adoption of the FY 2026 Budget, the City Commission approved contributions to not-for-profit organizations that support the needs of the community. The benefiting not-for-profit organization is required to execute a participation agreement that provides for amount, terms of contribution, scope of services, and standards of performance.

The mission of Museum of Discovery and Science, Inc. (MODS), is: Connecting people to inspiring science. MODS provides interactive educational exhibits, an outdoor Science Park, science camps, lectures, events, and documentaries. The funding will be used to provide kindergarten through fifth-grade students in nineteen (19) public elementary schools located within the City of Fort Lauderdale with access to museum and school instruction to improve long-term academic success in the critical STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) disciplines.

In addition, MODS may use any remaining funds to provide kindergarten through fifth-grade students in the City of Fort Lauderdale's Parks and Recreation camp programs with museum and camp instruction. The program will focus on improving long-term academic success in the critical STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) disciplines. Instruction will include the option of full days of interactive educational activities at each participating park, full-day field trips to the Museum of Discovery and Science, or both.

The scope of services is described in the participation agreement, attached as Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$214,800 in FY 2026. Funding is budgeted and available in the listed account.
