TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Sanitary Sewer Pump Station B-10
Rehabilitation – Intercounty Engineering Inc. - \$1,471,139

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, with Intercounty Engineering Inc. for the Sanitary Sewer Pump Station B-10 Rehabilitation in the amount of \$1,471,139.

Background

Pump Station B-10, located at 2152 Imperial Point Drive, serves a large sewer basin area in the Imperial Point area of Fort Lauderdale which includes the Imperial Point Hospital as a major contributor.

The best available information indicates that the station was constructed in the early 1960's. Much of the station equipment is old, outdated, and in dire need of upgrading or rehabilitating. The proposed work will completely rehabilitate the station including the removal and replacement of all existing pumping equipment, ladders, grates, and hatches; electrical, instrumentation, mechanical, and ventilation equipment; force main piping connections; and by-pass pumping connection.

On April 27, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Number 673-11888. Six bids were received on June 1, 2017. All bids received were reviewed for compliance with the specifications of the bid, and Intercounty Engineering Inc. has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$1,471,139 for construction and \$176,561 for estimated in-house project management fees, or a total of \$1,647,700. Funds for this contract in the amount of \$1,647,700 are available in the FY 2017 Community Investment Plan in the account listed below with \$344,771 contingent upon the approval of the consolidated budget amendment CAM 17-0751.
