### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission amend Ordinance No. C-75-16, expanding membership of the Citizens' Committee of Recognition to include one former Commission member and one additional past honoree from any existing award category other than exemplary former city employee.

# **Background**

At the October 2, 2012 Conference meeting the City Commission agreed by consensus to expand the Citizen's Committee of Recognition to include two additional members as noted above. At the November 2, 2012 Regular meeting the City Commission Ordinance passed on First Reading.

### ORDINANCE NO. C-12-42

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. C-75-16, AS AMENDED, EXPANDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE CITIZENS' COMMITTEE OF RECOGNITION TO INCLUDE ONE FORMER COMMISSION MEMBER AND ONE ADDITIONAL PAST HONOREE FROM ANY EXISTING AWARD CATEGORY OTHER THAN EXEMPLARY FORMER CITY EMPLOYEE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. C-75-16 adopted on April 1, 1975, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale established a Citizens' Board of Recognition ("Board"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. C-75-103 adopted on November 18, 1975 and Ordinance No. C-03-42 adopted on December 2, 2003, amendments were made to the membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. C-06-05 adopted on February 7, 2006, the name of the Citizens' Board of Recognition was changed to Citizens' Committee of Recognition; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to expand the membership of the Citizens' Committee of Recognition in order to preserve the existence of the Committee; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, to expand the membership of said Citizens' Committee of Recognition to include one former Commission member and one additional past honoree;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Section 3, of Ordinance No. C-75-16, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## SECTION 3.

Membership shall be comprised of <u>all</u> former mayors of the City of Fort Lauderdale, <u>one former Commission member</u>, two past honorees from any existing award category other than Exemplary Former City Employee, and the president of the Council of Fort Lauderdale Civic Associations, or the president's designee. The City shall appoint by resolution each former mayor for a

life term. The term of service for each of the appointees who is not a former mayor shall be one year. The chairman of the <u>Committee</u> shall be elected by the Committee of its membership.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That except as amended, Ordinance No. C-75-16, as amended, adopted on April 1, 1975, is hereby ratified and reaffirmed.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That if any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days from the date of final passage.
