TITLE: Overview of Florida Statute § 255.065, "Public-private partnerships" -
(Commission Districts 1,2, 3 and 4)

In 2013, the Florida Legislature passed HB 85 authorizing public-private partnerships for certain purposes and establishing requirements for such partnerships. Public-private partnerships are contractual agreements formed between public entities and private sector entities to allow for greater private sector participation in the delivery and financing of public building and infrastructure projects. The legislation has been amended over time and at the request of the City Commission, the City Attorney's Office will provide an overview of Florida Statute § 255.065.
