TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement for Invitation to Bid No. 491-2, After-School

Snack and Dinner Provider - All Kids Catering, Inc. - \$544,500 -

(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for After-School Snack and Dinner Provider services with All Kids Catering, Inc. for an initial one (1)-year contract term amount of \$544,500; and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement and approve up to four (4) additional, one (1)-year renewal options, for an estimated annual contract renewal amount of \$544,500, for a potential total contract amount of \$2,722,500, contingent upon appropriation of funds. The agreement is reimbursable through the Florida Department of Health.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale Parks and Recreation Department has been approved by the Florida Department of Health to serve two (2) types of meals - afternoon snack and dinner - at the City's after-school and teen programs at seven (7) designated City facilities: Bass Park, Carter Park, Croissant Park, Osswald Park, Riverland Park, Warfield Park, and Lauderdale Manors.

The City has provided snacks to after-school participants since 2015 and began serving dinners in October 2024. The program is grant-funded and 100% reimbursable through the Florida Department of Health, which ensures participants receive healthy and nutritious meals while attending City programs.

The Florida Department of Health approval allows the City to provide snacks for up to 400 participants and dinners for up to 550 participants in year one. In years two through five, the City can provide snacks for up to 425 participants and dinners for up to 650 participants. Based on recent program trends, staff estimates serving 72,000 snacks and 99,000 dinners in year one. It is anticipated that the program will grow to 76,500 snacks and 117,000 dinners in future years.

On July 2, 2025, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 491-2 for an After-School Snack and Dinner Provider. The Event closed on July 22, 09/16/2025

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2025, with two (2) bids received from:

- All Kids Catering, Inc.
- Farm to Fork Meals LLC

All Kids Catering, Inc. has met the solicitation requirements of the ITB and was deemed to be the low, responsive, and responsible bidder. Therefore, staff recommends All Kids Catering, Inc. for award.
