TITLE:	Motion to approve the purchase of computer software and hardware to meet the state security requirements, Invitation to Bid (ITB) 532-11137 - \$53,091

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of system hardware and software to implement advanced authentication for mobile laptops. These laptops will access the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's (FDLE) Criminal Justice Network (CJNET). The total cost is not to exceed \$53,091 from Mission Critical Systems, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, to provide RSA SecurID hardware and software for two-factor authentication.

Background

The State has increased the security requirements associated with computer systems accessing Criminal Justice Information (CJI) through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's (FLDE) Criminal Justice Network (CJNet) to require advanced authentication. The State requires compliance by September, 2013. This will affect every officer using the Mobile Data Terminal (MDT) software or accessing CJNet in patrol vehicles, as well as officers accessing CJI through workstations or laptops through the Virtual Private Network (VPN). Officers access CJI through the use of the MDT software to perform queries to the Florida Crime Information Center for license plates, vehicle registrations, suspects, guns, and other articles. Officers also access other databases through CJNET such as Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) for driver license photos for identification (ID), county warrant searches, name and property searches etc.

There are two components to this project and this purchase will provide the two-factor component, which entails the use of the RSA SecurID hardware and software system (security token/key fob), manufactured by RSA. This will be used by patrol officers to generate a unique ID used as an additional unique identifier for each logon. Since this software and hardware is made available for purchase through RSA partners, the

Procurement Services Division issued an ITB. Three responses to this solicitation were received with Mission Critical Systems, Inc. providing the lowest responsive price of \$53,091.

The second component to this project will be the technology designed to allow for the necessary remote access (Netmotion VPN). The purchase of the Netmotion VPN solution required a separate competitive purchase solicitation and will be presented for approval at a future City Commission meeting.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$53,091.
