

RESOLUTION NO. 26-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, WAIVING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST FOR NIKOLA STAN, MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL CITY REDEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD OF THE FORT LAUDERDALE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY.

WHEREAS, at the June 3, 2025, meeting of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, City Commission meeting, the City Commission voted to appoint Nikola Stan to the Central City Redevelopment Advisory Board ("CCRAB"); and

WHEREAS, as an advisory board member of the CCRAB, Nikola Stan is considered a public officer and subject to the Florida Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees set forth in Part III, Chapter 112, Florida Statutes (Ethics Act), which restricts public officers from doing business with the Fort Lauderdale Community Redevelopment Agency and from having a contractual relationship with a person or entity which is subject to the regulation of or doing business with the Fort Lauderdale Community Redevelopment Agency; and

WHEREAS, Nikola Stan has requested a waiver under Florida Statute, Section 112.313 (12), which allows the City Commission, by a two-thirds vote, to approve an exception to the prohibition in Section 112.313(7) and allow him to apply for incentives under the Central City Incentive Program of the Central City Community Redevelopment Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the requirements of Section 112.313(7), Florida Statutes, applicable to Nikola Stan arising from his appointment to CCRAB are hereby waived to allow him to apply for incentives under the Central City Incentive Program of the Central City Community Redevelopment Area.

SECTION 2. This waiver shall not be deemed a waiver of any other conflicts.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
