Providing for an Extension of the Term of the Infrastructure Task Force

Advisory Committee – (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution extending the length of term for the Infrastructure Task Force Advisory Committee (ITFAC) to February 18, 2025, recognizing the importance of the ITFAC in supporting the City's infrastructure efforts, its residents, visitors, businesses, and current and future development.

## **Background**

The Infrastructure Task Force Advisory Committee was created by Resolution No. 17-46 adopted on March 7, 2017, for an initial term of 18 months, until September 7, 2018. This term was further extended until March 7, 2020. Resolution 20-30 adopted on February 18, 2020, extended the length of the term for the ITFAC to February 18, 2022.

This resolution will extend the term for the ITFAC until February 18, 2025.

#### **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact in the amount of \$5,000 for this resolution. Funds are available in the FY 2022 Operating Budget in the account listed below. Future years' expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
