

RESOLUTION NO. 17-136

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NOS. 16-192 AND 16-206 TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE INNOVATIVE DEVELOPMENT (ID) DISTRICT ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND THE TERMS OF THE ID DISTRICT ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-192 adopted on November 1, 2016, the City Commission established the Innovative Development (ID) District Advisory Committee, with a termination date of July 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-206 adopted November 15, 2016, members were appointed to the ID District Advisory Committee, for one year terms beginning November 15, 2016 and ending November 14, 2017, or until their successors have been appointed; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to extend the term of the ID District Advisory Committee and the terms of the ID District Advisory Committee members to January 31, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 6 of Resolution No. 16-192 is hereby amended to read as follows:

That the Innovative Development (ID) District Advisory Committee shall commence on the date this Resolution is adopted and shall terminate on January 31, 2018.

SECTION 2. That Exhibit to Resolution No. 16-206 is hereby amended to read as follows:

INNOVATIVE DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Leigh Kerr, Jason Crush, Mary Fertig, James Brady, Catherine Maus, Peter Henn and Mario Cartaya are appointed to the Innovative Development District Advisory Committee for one year terms beginning November 15, 2016 and ending January 31, 2018, or until their successors have been appointed.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and adoption.
