**TITLE:** Motion to Approve Contract for Streetbond Asphalt Coating Services – MBR Construction, Inc. - \$186,474

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract, in substantially the form attached, to MBR Construction, Inc. (MBR) to provide and install Streetbond asphalt coating in the estimated amount of \$186,474.

**Background**

The Transportation and Mobility (TAM) Department is requesting to award a contract for resurfacing the TAM and Beach Community Center parking lots with solar reflective coating. Solar reflective coating systems are designed to provide the following benefits:

- Strengthens the asphalt base and lengthens the life of the asphalt beyond its normal range.
- Reduces heat absorption by 60%.
- Helps qualify for LEED (leadership in energy and environmental design) points and Green Parking Certification.

On April 21, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 273-11953. Two bids were received on May 15, 2017. Both responses submitted were reviewed for compliance with the specifications of the bid and MBR has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

**Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$186,474 for the FY 2017 budget in the accounts listed below. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the FY 2018 budget.
