Dear Mayor Seiler, Mr. Feldman and Mr Abbate:

I'm sorry for the tardy nature of this letter, but I hope this will help in your efforts to build a firstclass aquatic facility in the city of Fort Lauderdale.

I would first like to say that USA Swimming is incredibly thankful for the many years that the city of Fort Lauderdale has spent promoting aquatics and hosting events. I still remember, like it was yesterday, the U.S. Nationals at the Hall of Fame pool in 2002, at which a 16-year old Michael Phelps had the breakout competition of his career, setting a world record in the 400 IM.

In regard to your efforts to build a "world class" facility, I do believe that the city should consider re-evaluating the plans that are currently in place. USA Swimming does have a serious concern about bringing major events to a facility that has a four-story vertical difference between a competition pool and the warm-up pool. This would present a challenge for athletes and coaches on a number of fronts, specifically, the climbing of a significant amount of stairs in order to get to and from the pools. There is also a concern about having a warm-up area so far removed from the competition pool with athletes of all ages, in particular with supervision of those athletes.

I would also like to add that having two 50-meter pools, side-by-side, would put Fort Lauderdale in an elite category of facilities around the U.S. If the pools had the proper lane width and depth, that would be a huge advantage for attracting international and national competitions to your city.
