TITLE: Acceptance of FY2014 Department of Homeland Security Port Security Grant Program - \$4,070

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$4,070 from the FY2014 Department of Homeland Security Port Security Grant Program (PSGP).

Background

In May 2014, the City submitted a proposal to the United States Department of Homeland Security - Port Security Grant Program, which included the purchase of equipment to enhance the Fort Lauderdale Police Department Marine Unit's ability to protect our local waterways from suspicious vessels and enhance their response as members of the Regional Domestic Security Task Force. The City of Fort Lauderdale was awarded \$4,070 in PSGP funding towards the purchase of the radiation detectors, which will be deployed during daily patrols and special events in the City. The grant period is September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2016.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$4,070. Matching funds are not required. Funding was approved through consolidated budget CAM 14-1219 at the December 2, 2014 regular agenda meeting.
