TITLE: Resolution Approving an Interlocal Agreement Between Broward County

and City of Fort Lauderdale for Surtax-Funded Municipal Transportation Project: Roadway Improvement (FORT 104) for the City's Sidewalk

Connections Project - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving and authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and City of Fort Lauderdale for Surtax-Funded Municipal Transportation Project: Roadway Improvement (FORT-104) ("ILA"), in substantially the form attached, for funding of the City's Sidewalk Connections project utilizing Transportation Surtax Funding.

Background

On January 21, 2021, the City Commission approved a Second Amendment to the Transportation Surtax Interlocal Agreement to become eligible to receive funding for awarded transportation surtax projects. Each specific project requires its own Interlocal Agreement with the County to define and memorialize the project scope, timeline, and funding.

The City's Sidewalk Connections project was awarded as part of Cycle One applications in 2020. The proposed ILA for design in the amount of \$360,0000 will set the project schedule and deliverables, reporting requirements, and funding schedule that must be followed by the City for the design portion of the project. The City Attorney's Office cautions that the ILA provides for broad indemnification by the City in favor of the County and others and the City's defense of the indemnitees under various circumstances.

The citywide Sidewalk Connections project will be applied to 35 streets throughout the city. The location of the sidewalk connections is limited to the locations that were included in the 2020 surtax application. The design elements include five foot wide by six-inchthick sidewalks in areas where there are no sidewalks and areas where there are existing sidewalk gaps.

The specific locations and sidewalks lengths are:

Once the design is completed, the surtax award includes construction funding in the amount of \$2,640,000. The City will be required to enter into another interlocal agreement with Broward County for the construction phase.

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$360,000. Funding was appropriated to the accounts below on the January 9, 2024, Consolidated Budget Amendment (CAM 24-0013).
