This cause having come before this Special Magistrate as a Repeat Violation, and the Special Magistrate having heard argument thereon, does hereby issue a finding of fact:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

 That violation of Section 18-12.(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale occurred between the dates of August 17, 2022, through October 16, 2022, to wit: THERE IS AN ACCUMULATION OF LEAVES ON THIS PROPERTY AND/OR ITS SWALE.

That violation of Section 47-20.20.(H) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale beginning August 17, 2022, and hereby remaining in non-compliance, to wit: THERE ARE PARKING FACILITIES THAT ARE NOT MAINTAINED AT THIS PROPERTY.

- 2. Pursuant to Section 11-10(c) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, the Special Magistrate finds that these repeat violations are subject to the accrual of fines from the date the violations were noted to exist by the Code Enforcement officer until the date the violation comes into compliance at the rate of \$150.00 per day.
- That the stated violation of Sections 18-12.(a) and 47-20.20.(H) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale occurred on the following described real property:

#### PROSPECT INDUSTRIAL CENTER 40-38 B LOT 17 & 18

More commonly known as 1071 NW 54 STREET

- 4. Any future violations of Sections 47-20:20.(H) and 18-12.(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale shall be subject to fines of up to \$500.00 per day.
- 5. The Special Magistrate, on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June 2023, did impose fines in the amount of \$3,800.00. which continues to accrue.
- 6. The City shall record a certified copy of this Order in the Public Records of Broward County 30 days from the above date of the Special Magistrate Hearing. Once recorded, this Order shall constitute a lien on the subject property as well as on any other real or personal property owned by the Respondent.
