Application for \$75,000 to the Florida Inland Navigation District – Waterway Assistance Program to Design and Permit Boat Ramp

Renovations at the Lauderdale Isles Landing (f/k/a Riverland Woods Boat

Ramp) - (Commission District 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to submit an Application for Grant Funding of \$75,000 to the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) – Waterways Assistance Program. This Grant requires a City match of \$75,000.

Background

The Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) administers the Waterway Assistance Program (WAP) program. FIND provides funding assistance to local governments within the District to provide public access to the District's waterways.

Lauderdale Isles Landing (f/k/a Riverland Woods boat ramp) was acquired by the City from Broward County in 2002 as part of the City's annexation of the Riverland Road area. Since then, the City has upgraded the entrance road to the boat ramp and repaired the existing ramp. The design and permitting work will consist of permitting a design to widen the existing ramp and to reconfigure the ramp's staging docks in order to reduce congestion and provide better efficiency in launching and retrieving boats.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with the grant application. The Grant will be brought back to the City Commission for execution and appropriation if awarded.
