The Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) Trust Quarterly Investment Report for the period Ending December 31, 2019 was provided as part of March 3, 2020 Commission Conference Item CF-1.

Chair Trantalis recognized Susan Grant, Director of Finance. Ms. Grant reiterated her earlier comments regarding the March 3, 2020 Commission Conference Meeting item CF-1, expounding on details regarding the traditional Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) and the Pay-Step Plan investment portfolios included in the \$37,000,000 investments. She explained details related to the reallocation into Index Funds. The current quarter exceeds the benchmark and improved performance is anticipated with reallocations.
