

RESOLUTION NO. 21-248

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR A THREE PERCENT MERIT SALARY INCREASE FOR CITY ATTORNEY ALAIN E. BOILEAU, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 18-175, the City Commission appointed Alain E. Boileau as City Attorney and approved an Employment Contract with him to serve as City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the Employment Contract between the City of Fort Lauderdale and City Attorney Alain E. Boileau provides that the City "may grant merit increases to such extent as the CITY may determine that it is desirable to do so on the basis of an annual performance review."; and


WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that based on his annual performance review, City Attorney Alain E. Boileau merits a salary increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That City Attorney Alain E. Boileau's annual base salary be and is hereby increased by three percent effective November 1, 2021.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
