## **RESOLUTION NO. 21-252**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 21-151, APPROVING A HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE BAYVIEW DRIVE COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2015, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City"), authorized the submittal of an application to the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") for funding the Bayview Drive Complete Streets Project ("Bayview Drive Project"), through its Transportation Alternatives Program; and

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2017, the City endorsed the Bayview Drive Project to receive funding from the MPO; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded 2.7 million dollars to fund the design, construction, and construction engineering and inspection of the Bayview Drive Project; and

WHEREAS, Bayview Drive is part of the City's roadway system under the jurisdiction of the City of Fort Lauderdale and is thereby maintained by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT) is authorized, pursuant to Sections 339.07, 339.08, and 339.12, Florida Statutes and Federal funding provisions, to undertake projects within the City's geographical limits; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, FDOT began the design phase of the Bayview Drive Project; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Bayview Drive Project is to improve vehicular, sidewalk, pedestrian, and bicycle safety, on Bayview Drive between Sunrise Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Bayview Drive Project involves constructing missing bike lanes and sidewalks, installing crosswalks, raised intersections, medians, and roundabouts for traffic calming and any associated drainage required due to the improvements; and

WHEREAS, the overall estimated project cost is 3.3 million dollars; and

WHEREAS, FDOT and the City agree to permit FDOT to construct the improvements for the Bayview Drive Project and it is the responsibility of the City to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways after the project's completion; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2021, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 21-151, approving and authorizing execution of the Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and the Florida Department of Transportation for the Bayview Drive Complete Streets Project; and

WHEREAS, the scope of services was modified, by the Florida Department of Transportation, to remove references to the installation of rectangular rapid flashing beacons at midblock crossings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Resolution No. 21-151 of the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is hereby rescinded.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes execution of the Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and the Florida Department of Transportation for the Bayview Drive Complete Streets Project, attached to City Commission Agenda Memo #21-0997.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That if any clause, section, or other part of this resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
