RESOLUTION NO. 22-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE LAUDERTRAIL MASTER PLAN AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in May 2018, the City Commission requested that a Working Group be established to lead the idea of a pedestrian/bicycle trail; and

WHEREAS, the LauderTrail Working Group was established for a two-year period beginning August 1, 2018, and was charged with advancing the concept of creating a citywide trail system; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Parks, Recreation, and Beaches Board ("Board"), on January 5, 2021, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 21-08, which approved the Board's recommendation of the LauderTrail/Linear Trail Project and to finance the cost of the project with proceeds from the Parks and Recreation Series 2020A General Obligation Bonds; and

WHEREAS, in March 2021, the City of Fort Lauderdale approved the PATH Foundation to lead the development of the LauderTrail Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the PATH Foundation has completed the Master Plan, which memorializes the existing conditions of Fort Lauderdale's multi-modal network and has identified proposed routes and implementation recommendations to create a city-wide trail system; and

WHEREAS, the Master Plan identifies a cost estimate of over \$90,000,000 for the entire trail system for design and construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby accepts the LauderTrail Master Plan, as shown in Exhibit "1" to the City Commission Agenda Memo 21-0837.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and adoption.
