TITLE: Resolution Delegating Authority to the City Manager to Execute a Project

Agreement with the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) for a Grant of up to \$260,000 for Bill Keith Preserve Shoreline Stabilization Phase II -

(Commission District 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Commission adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute with FIND Project Agreement to fund 50% of the project cost for the Bill Keith Shoreline Stabilization PH II, but not to exceed \$260,000. This Grant Requires a City Match of \$260,000 plus estimated internal project management fees of \$104,000. The Resolution further authorized the City Manager to execute any and all documents or instruments reasonably necessary or incidental to administration of the Project Agreement.

Background

The Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) administers the Waterway Assistance Program (WAP) program. FIND provides funding assistance to local governments within the District to provide public access to the waterways and shoreline stabilization.

The Bill Keith Preserve is a 4-acre natural area located along the South Fork of New River just east of the I-95 overpass. The preserve was created by the City of Fort Lauderdale, area neighbors and the Shady Banks Association. Over time, wakes created by vessel traffic along that stretch of the river has significantly eroded the shoreline in the preserve.

The project will consist of Phase II Construction activities needed to grade, fill and place a boulder wave break along the shoreline of the park. Total project costs including internal project management fees are estimated at \$624,000.

The City Commission approved applying for this grant at its February 16, 2021 regular meeting.

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$260,000 for the grant acceptance which will be appropriated to the account below contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 21-1111.
